AN ACT RELATIVE TO EXEMPTING CERTAIN MEDICAL SUPPLIES FROM THE STATE  
SALES TAX.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 64H of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended, in clause (1), by inserting after the word "insulin;" in line 171, the  
3 following words:- sales of blood test strips and lancets; sales of vitamin and mineral supplements  
4 when prescribed by a licensed physician;
