AN ACT RELATIVE TO FEES FOR SENIORS FILING WITH THE TAX APPELLATE BOARD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 7 of chapter 58A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2002 official  
2 edition, is amended in line 28 by inserting after the words “or both,” with the following words:-  
3 “or persons over the age of 65 who file an appeal from the board of assessors and with a gross  
4 income of 200% of the federal poverty level shall pay a entry fee of more than twenty-five  
5 dollars.”
