AN ACT RELATIVE TO FLEA MARKET VENDORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. The definition of "Transient Vendor" in Section 1 of Chapter 101 of the General
   Laws as so appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding after the first
   sentence the following: "The provisions of this chapter will not apply to vendors and promoters in flea markets so
   called."
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 2 of Chapter 101 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out
  7 the last sentence of this paragraph and inserting the following:-
- 8 "The provisions of this chapter will not apply to vendors and promoters in flea markets so9 called."
