AN ACT RELATIVE TO GANG VIOLENCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 265 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after
- 2 section 13L the following section:-
- 3 Section 13M. For the purposes of this section, the following words shall have the following
- 4 meanings:—
- 5 "Gang assault and battery", assault and battery when aided by three or more persons actually
- 6 present.
- 7 "Serious bodily injury", bodily injury which results in a permanent disfigurement, protracted loss
- 8 or impairment of a bodily function, limb or organ, or substantial risk of death.
- 9 (a) Whoever commits a gang assault and battery upon another person and by such assault and
- battery causes bodily injury shall be punished by imprisonment punished by imprisonment in a

- house of correction for not more than 3 years, or by a fine of not more than \$2,500, or both such
- fine and imprisonment.
- 13 (b) Whoever commits a gang assault and battery upon another person and by such assault and
- battery causes serious bodily injury shall be punished by imprisonment punished by
- imprisonment in a house of correction for not more than 5 years, or by a fine of not more than
- \$5000, or both such fine and imprisonment.
