## AN ACT RELATIVE TO INCOME VERIFICATION OF NON-CUSTODIAL PARENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

| 1 | SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any special or general law to the contrary the probate and family       |

| 3 | revenue, shall promulgate regulations for the verification of income of non-custodial parents      |
| 4 | used to determine child support payments. Said regulations shall require that all non-custodial    |
| 5 | parents present at least two forms of documentation that can be used to verify the individual's    |
| 6 | income. Said regulations shall also require third party verification of the non-custodial parent's |
| 7 | income, and if said verification determines that false information was provided, that it be        |
| 8 | considered when determining child support payments and visitation rights of the individual         |
| 9 | supplying false information.   |
