AN ACT RELATIVE TO JUVENILE INTIMIDATION OF WITNESSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           SECTION 1. Chapter 119 of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby amended in the
- 2           third paragraph of section 54 by adding after the words “chapter two hundred and sixty-nine,” in
- 3           first sentence the following:- or the person has committed a violation of section thirteen B of
- 4           chapter two hundred and sixty-eight,
  
- 5           SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
