AN ACT RELATIVE TO MENTAL HEALTH PARITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 22 of Chapter 32A of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
2	out subsection (a) and inserting in place the following subsection:
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4	(a) The commission shall provide to any active or retired employee of the commonwealth who is
5	insured under the group insurance commission coverage on a nondiscriminatory basis for the
6	diagnosis and treatment of the following biologically-based mental disorders, as described in
7	the most recent edition of the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders
8	published by the American Psychiatric Association, referred to in this section as the DSM:
9	(1) schizophrenia; (2) schizoaffective disorder; (3) major depressive disorder; (4) bipolar
10	disorder; (5) paranoia and other psychotic disorders; (6) obsessive-compulsive disorder; (7)
11	panic disorder; (8) delirium and dementia; (9) affective disorders; (10) eating disorders; (11)
12	post traumatic stress disorders; (12) substance abuse disorders; (13) autism; and (14) any
13	biologically-based mental disorders appearing in the DSM and approved by the

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commissioner of the department of mental health in consultation with the commissioner of the division of insurance.

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SECTION 2. Section 47B of Chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out
subsection (a) and inserting in place the following subsection:

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(a) Any individual policy of accident and sickness insurance issued pursuant to section 108, 20 which provides hospital expense and surgical expense insurance, and any group blanket or 21 22 general policy of accident and sickness insurance issued pursuant to section 110, which provides hospital expense and surgical expense insurance, which is issued or renewed within 23 or without the commonwealth, shall provide mental health benefits on a nondiscriminatory 24 basis to residents of the commonwealth and to all policyholders having a principal place of 25 employment in the commonwealth for the diagnosis and treatment of the following 26 27 biologically-based mental disorders, as described in the most recent edition of the Diagnostic 28 and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders published by the American Psychiatric 29 Association, referred to in this section as the DSM: (1) schizophrenia, (2) schizoaffective 30 disorder, (3) major depressive disorder, (4) bipolar disorder, (5) paranoia and other psychotic 31 disorders, (6) obsessive-compulsive disorder, (7) panic disorder, (8) delirium and dementia, 32 (9) affective disorders; (10) eating disorders; (11) post traumatic stress disorders; (12) 33 substance abuse disorders; (13) autism and (14) any biologically-based mental disorders appearing in the DSM and approved by the commissioner of the department of mental health 34 35 in consultation with the commissioner of the division of insurance. 36

61	subscribers and members within the commonwealth and to all group members having a
62	principal place of employment in the commonwealth for the diagnosis and treatment of the
63	following biologically-based mental disorders, as described in the most recent edition of the

64	Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders published by the American
65	Psychiatric Association, referred to in this section as the DSM: (1) schizophrenia; (2)
66	schizoaffective disorder; (3) major depressive disorder; (4) bipolar disorder; (5) paranoia and
67	other psychotic disorders; (6) obsessive-compulsive disorder; (7) panic disorder; (8) delirium

81	Manual of Mental Disorders published by the American Psychiatric Association, referred to
82	in this section as the DSM: (1) schizophrenia; (2) schizoaffective disorder; (3) major
83	depressive disorder; (4) bipolar disorder; (5) paranoia and other psychotic disorders; (6)
