AN ACT RELATIVE TO MOORING PERMITS ASSIGNED TO ENTITIES FOR RENTAL OR LEASING PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 10A of Chapter 91 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official
- 2 Edition, is amended, after the 2<sup>nd</sup> paragraph, by inserting the following new paragraph:-
- 3 The harbormaster may issue mooring permits to any individual or entity, including to public or private
- 4 facilities, and to for-profit or non-profit entities for rental or leasing purposes on an annual basis. Any
- 5 individual or entity which leases or rents permitted moorings shall annually provide the harbormaster
- 6 with a list of vessels moored on the permitted mooring. Mooring permits assigned to entities which lease
- 7 or rent moorings shall be renewed annually absent demonstration of cause pursuant to a due
- 8 process hearing. Mooring permit holders which lease or rent permitted moorings shall also be responsible
- 9 for fair and equitable assignment of any vacant moorings. Methods of fair and equitable assignment
- for all moorings may include but are not limited to one or more of the following: (1) date of application;
- 11 (2) physical characteristics of the vessel; (3) purpose of the vessel; and (4) renewal or issuance of a

12	mooring assignment to individual members, patrons, or customers, including but not limited to members,
13	patrons and customers of a for profit or non-profit facility.
