### AN ACT RELATIVE TO POSTING EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 151A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 official edition, is hereby amended by inserting after section 63 the following new section:-
- 3 Section 63A. Every agency, authority and institution of the commonwealth shall transmit to the
- 4 commissioner all employment opportunity notices and postings, including, but not limited to, notices of
- 5 job opportunities, new positions and vacancies. The commissioner shall immediately place all such
- 6 information in the statewide employment computerized referral system and in the printed periodic
- 7 bulletin. No position shall be filled without full compliance with this section.
