**AN ACT RELATIVE TO PROJECTS FUNDED BY THE SCHOOL BUILDING AUTHORITY.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 9 of Chapter 70B, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby
- 2 amended by adding at the end of subsection (a), the following:- (5) the applicant shall not enter into a
- 3 contract for design services unless the designer has obtained professional liability insurance covering
- 4 negligent errors, omissions and acts of the designer or of an person or business entity for whose
- 5 performance the designer is legally liable arising out of the performance of the contract.
- 6 Notwithstanding the provisions of Chapter 7 Section 38H paragraph (f), the total amount of such
- 7 insurance shall at a minimum equal fifty per cent of the project's estimated cost of construction, or such
- 8 larger amounts as the board may require, for the applicable limitations. A designer required by the
- 9 authority to obtain all or a portion of such insurance coverage at his own expense shall furnish a
- 10 certificate of certificates of insurance coverage to the applicant prior to the award of the contract.
