AN ACT RELATIVE TO PROTECTING THE IDENTITY OF A 911 CALLER.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 7 of chapter 4 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "individual", in line 142, the  
3   following words:- including but not limited to the name, address or phone number of an  
4   individual who called 911 to report an emergency.
