AN ACT RELATIVE TO SENDING NOTICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE PROCEEDINGS TO VICTIMS .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 3 of Chapter 258B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by adding the following new subsection after subsection (b) and renumbering the
- 3 remainder of the subsections: -
- 4 (c) for victims, to be notified by the prosecutor, in a timely manner, of all court proceedings related to
- 5 the offense committed against the victim, by certified mail sent to the last known address of the victim
- 6 as well as by a telephone call. In order to properly notify victims, a form shall be provided to them by the
- 7 prosecutor for the purpose of maintaining a current telephone number and address. The victim or
- 8 witness shall thereafter maintain with the prosecutor a current telephone number and address;
