AN ACT RELATIVE TO TEEN VIOLENCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 209A of the Massachusetts General Laws, is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting after the word "members", in the fourth line, the following words:- or of a
- 3 minor child by a person with whom the minor child has had or is having a dating relationship, or
- 4 of an adult by a person with whom the adult has had or is having a dating relationship.
- 5 SECTION 2. Section 3 of Chapter 209A of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby amended
- 6 by inserting after the word "abuse", in the first line, the following:- or the custodial or non-
- 7 custodial parent or guardian, on behalf of a minor child suffering from abuse.
