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AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE BARGAINABILITY OF HEALTH INSURANCE FOR PART-TIME  
MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 32B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2000  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the first sentence of subsection (d) in line  
3   36 the following: — Persons who are ineligible because their duties require less than twenty  
4   hours, regularly, during the regular work week may be provided health insurance pursuant to the  
5   provisions of a collective bargaining agreement.

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
