AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COMMISSION OF A CRIME WHILE IN POSESSION OF A POLICE SCANNER .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 266 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting after section 49 the following section:-
- 3 Section 49A. Whoever, while in the commission of a crime, knowingly has in their possession a police
- 4 scanner with the intent to use or employ said scanner to aid in the commission of such crime shall be
- 5 punished by imprisonment in the state prison for not more than ten years or by a fine of not more than
- 6 one thousand dollars and imprisonment in jail for not more than two and one-half years.
