## AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COMMUNITY PRESERVATION ACT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 7 of chapter 44B, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking out the
- 2 definition of "Rehabilitation" and inserting in place thereof the following new definition:
- 3 "Rehabilitation", the remodeling, restoration, reconstruction and making of extraordinary repairs
- 4 to historic resources, open spaces, lands for recreational use and community housing for the
- 5 purpose of making such historic resources, open spaces, lands for recreational use and
- 6 community housing functional for their intended use, including but not limited to improvements
- 7 to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act and other federal, state or local building or
- 8 access codes or for aesthetic restoration. With respect to historic resources, rehabilitation shall
- 9 have the additional meaning of work to comply with the Standards for Rehabilitation stated in
- the United States Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties
- codified in 36 C.F.R. Part 68.
