AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE GRANTING LEAVE OF PAY FOR INJURIES SUSTAINED ON THE  
JOB AS POLICE OFFICER OR FIRE FIGHTER.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 111f of chapter 41 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1996  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "any", in line 19, the following  
3 words:- Port Officer, Port Sergeant and Port Lieutenant; by inserting after the word "Airport" in  
4 line 21, the following words:- , and the Port of Boston; and after the word "district", in line 23,  
5 the following words:- , and police district.
