Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 25 of chapter 83 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-
 - Cities and towns shall provide reflective lights at crosswalks to ensure the safety of pedestrians traveling on the public ways within a municipality. The reflective light shall be of such design as the commissioner of highways determines necessary for the safe crossing of pedestrians.
