AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RIGHTS OF CHILDREN ADOPTED BY UNMARRIED PERSONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 210 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition  
2 is hereby amended by inserting after Section 6E, the following section:-

3           Section 6F. After an adjudication of adoption, in the event that the adoptive parents are not  
4 married to each other, in any dispute as may arise as to custody, visitation, support, education,  
5 maintenance and health insurance, the adoptive parent may seek relief under sections nine, ten,  
6 eleven, eighteen, nineteen and twenty of chapter two hundred and nine C provided however that  
7 the provisions of paragraph B of section 10 of chapter two hundred and nine C shall not apply to  
8 this section.
