### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TAXATION OF PENSIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Subparagraph (4) of paragraph (a) of said subsection B of section 3 of chapter 62 of  
2 the General Laws, as appearing in the 1998 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out in the  
3 third to last line, the words "to the extent that income from any such similar fund established under the  
4 laws of the commonwealth is not subject to taxation in such other state or political subdivision."
