AN ACT RELATIVE TO VICTIMS RIGHTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 228 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 14
- 2 the following section:-

- 3 Section 15. The death of a criminal defendant who is convicted of a criminal offense shall
- 4 automatically terminate the right to appeal or any appeal pending of such conviction, and where
- 5 such conviction has not been previously vacated or reversed by an order or decision of a court,
- 6 the judgment of conviction shall stand.
- 8 This section shall not preclude the attorney general or district attorney from commencing an
- 9 action to vacate the conviction judgment against a deceased defendant in the interest of justice.
