### AN ACT REQUIRING PROOF OF RESIDENCY OF CHARTER SCHOOL STUDENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 89(0) of Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
- 2 out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following:
- 3 Each charter school shall annually, no later than April 1, notify each public school district in
- 4 writing by providing it with at least the names, addresses, and dates of birth of the students who
- 5 will be attending the charter school from that district the following September, as well as the new
- 6 students who will be transferring from that district to the charter school in the following
- 7 September. The charter school shall also notify each public school district in writing no later
- 8 than October 15, March 1 and June 15 by providing it with at least the names, addresses, and
- 9 dates of birth of the students attending the charter school from the district as of October 1,
- 10 February 15 and June 1 respectively.
