AN ACT TO AMEND MGL CHAPTER 29.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (c) of [Section 29F of Chapter 29](#) of the General Laws, as appearing in the
2 2004 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking in line 52 the word "may" and inserting in place
3 thereof the word "shall".

4 SECTION 2. Subsection (c) of Section 29F of Chapter 29 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004
5 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking in lines 52 and 53 the words, "but, debarment shall be
6 imposed in all causes where debarment is required by law:"

7 SECTION 3. Subsection (d) of Section 29F of Chapter 29 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004
8 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking in line 98 the word "may" and inserting in place thereof
9 the word "shall".

10 SECTION 4. Subsection (e) of Section 29F of Chapter 29 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004
11 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking in line 133 the word "may" and inserting in place thereof
12 the word "shall".

13 SECTION 5. Subsection (f) of Section 29F of Chapter 29 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004
14 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking in line 157 the word "may" and inserting in place thereof
15 the word "shall".
