AN ACT TO CLARIFY CONTINUOUS SERVICE IN A RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 22 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2000
- 2 Official Edition, is amended in subsection (1)(b) by adding at the beginning, at line 21, the
- 3 following sentence:-
- For the purposes of this subsection any member in service who was laid off because of
- 5 reduction in force caused by budget cuts, whether or not such member withdrew contributions to
- 6 the retirement system, upon reinstatement and repayment of such contributions shall be
- 7 considered to have maintained continuous active service in the retirement system and such
- 8 member's rate of contribution shall be the same as the initial date of employment
