### AN ACT TO CLARIFY FARM PLATES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 5 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2000 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following new subsection:-
- 3 (5)(I) Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or specific law to the contrary, the registrar  
4 is hereby authorized and directed to issue farmer general registration number plates for terms of  
5 not less than three years, and to set the expiration date of such farmer general registration  
6 number plates in the months of January, February, or March.
