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AN ACT TO ENHANCE THE MANAGEMENT OF PROBLEM WILDLIFE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 80A of Chapter 131 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof, the following new  
3 paragraph: -

4 Any person issued a permit as provided by this section shall, within thirty days of the  
5 expiration of such permit or extension of same shall report to the director of the division  
6 of fisheries and wildlife, on a form approved by said director, the municipality of which  
7 the request was made, the name of the property owner, address of the property  
8 threatened, the name of authorized agent, method used to alleviate the problem, and the  
9 number and species of animals taken pursuant to the permit, and other information  
10 deemed necessary by the director.
