AN ACT TO ENHANCE TRAINING AND CAREER OPPORTUNITIES FOR YOUNG WORKERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1.

2   Chapter 25A of the General Laws, as most recently amended, is hereby further amended in Section 11C  
3   by adding at the end of the first sentence of the third paragraph after the word "non-negotiable" the  
4   following:- "and which shall include as a mandatory and non-negotiable condition a requirement that all  
5   offerers and contractors shall establish an apprentice training program which complies with the  
6   requirements of section 11E-11L of Chapter 23 of the Massachusetts General Laws for all trades  
7   represented in their workforce at the time of submitting a proposal."
