### AN ACT TO PROMOTE COMMUNITY SERVICE FOR MINOR OFFENSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The Boston Municipal Court shall operate a pilot program whereby offenders otherwise  
2 qualified under Chapter 276A, Sections 2-3 of the General Laws shall be offered the option of an order  
3 to perform community service in lieu of complaint. If the offender successfully completes the  
4 community service which is ordered then no record of the offense shall be recorded. If the offender fails  
5 to perform the community service as ordered then the complaint shall be filed and the offender shall be  
6 summonsed to court forthwith. The Boston Municipal Court shall report on the pilot program no later  
7 than December 31, 2008 by filing a report with the chairs of the Joint Committee on Public Safety and  
8 Homeland Security and the Joint Committee on the Judiciary.
