## AN ACT TO REDUCE CAR EMISSIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Executive  
2 Office of Transportation and Public Works in consultation with the Executive Office of Energy  
3 and Environmental Affairs shall, in order to prevent unnecessary vehicle idling, and thus  
4 excessive auto emissions, shall examine the possibility of removing all traffic signs that read no  
5 turn on red. Where it is determined that the sign is not required for traffic safety reasons, the  
6 signs shall be removed.
