AN ACT ESTABLISHING DISABILITY HISTORY MONTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 An Act Establishing a Disability History Month.

- 3 Section 15 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
- 4 adding after Section 15CCCCC the following section:-
- 5 Section 15DDDDD. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart the month of
- 6 October as Disability History Month to increase awareness and understanding of the
- 7 contributions that people with disabilities in our state, nation and the world have made to our
- 8 society. Appropriate state agencies and cities and towns and public schools and colleges shall
- 9 establish programs designed to educate and promote these objectives.
