AN ACT RELATIVE TO EXEMPTING CHILDREN'S BOOKS FROM STATE SALES TAX.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 64H of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following new paragraph:-

3 (ww) Sales of children's books, so called.
