AN ACT REQUIRING THE USE OF HEADLIGHTS IN INCLEMENT WEATHER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 7 of chapter 90 of the general laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended in the fourteenth sentence, by inserting after the words, "atmospheric
- 3 conditions," the words, ", or inclement weather," and by inserting after the word, "displayed,"
- 4 the phrase, "and every vehicle when using windshield wipers,"
- 5 For purposes of this act "inclement weather" is defined as a weather condition rendering a
- 6 driver's visibility from a motor vehicle insufficient to clearly discern a person or another motor
- 7 vehicle on the highway at a distance of 1,000 feet.
- 8 SECTION 2.
- 9 This act shall take effect upon its passage.
