AN ACT TO ALLOW HYBRID AND ALTERNATE FUEL VEHICLES IN HOV-DESIGNATED HIGHWAYY LANES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, motor vehicles
- 2 designated by the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency, the National Highway Traffic and
- 3 Safety Administration or the department of environmental protection as hybrid or alternate fuel
- 4 vehicles shall be authorized for travel on those lanes designated by the executive office of
- 5 transportation and construction for use by high-occupancy vehicles.
- 6 (b) The secretary of transportation and construction shall issue those regulations it considers
- 7 necessary or appropriate to implement this act.
