RESOLVE

1	Resolved, that a special commission is hereby establish for the purpose of conducting an
2	investigation and study of the feasibility of implementing a statewide school safety plan for all
3	public schools to coordinate evacuation and lockdown procedures as they pertain to all
4	emergencies. The commission shall study the best practices for the coordination of both law
5	enforcement and emergency response in an effort to ensure the safety of all students.
6	The commission shall also examine the current policies and procedures implemented by both
7	schools and law enforcement for dealing with an active shooter on the premises and shall make
8	recommendations relative to training necessary for law enforcement officers, school
9	administrators, and teachers.

11	The commission shall consist of the house and senate chairs of the joint committee on public
12	safety and homeland security, who shall serve as co-chairs of the commission; the house and
13	senate chairs of the joint committee on education; 1 member to be appointed by the senate
14	president, 1 member to be appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives; 1 member to
15	be appointed by the senate minority leader; 1 member to be appointed by the house minority
16	leader, the secretary of the executive office of public safety and security or his designee; the
17	secretary of the executive office of education or his designee, and 1 representative from each of

- the following organizations: the municipal police training committee; the Massachusetts Chiefs
- 19 of Police Association and the Massachusetts Teachers Association.

- 21 The commission shall report to the general court the results of its investigation and study and its
- 22 recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its
- recommendations into effect by filing the same with the clerks of the senate and house of
- representatives not later than 120 days after the first meeting of the commission.
